Vaccines have proven to be an effective tool against the virus. To date, no vaccinated resident has been impacted in this outbreak. Boosters were administered for all those consenting who received the Pfizer vaccine. In the next week, Boosters will be administered for all those consenting who received the Johnsons & Johnsons or the Moderna series. We continue to implement strategies to mitigate the virus and minimize the risk to our residents and staff. If you are feeling unwell, we ask you to schedule your visit for a later time.
