Dear Residents, Families and Friends:

Thank you for your patience and understanding as we work through outbreak testing. The great news is that we have completed two rounds of testing and have not identified any additional positive cases in residents or staff. This allows us to reopen our visitation. We will resume open visitation daily from 10 am to 6 pm. We request that all visitors enter through our Main Street doors so we can complete the required screening. We are also offering rapid COVID-19 testing for any visitors who would request it. All visitors, regardless of vaccination status, must wear masks while inside our building.

We will continue outbreak testing through next weekend per the regulation. Our visitation policies will be modified as needed if additional staff or residents test positive for the COVID-19. We continue to enforce strict mitigation efforts as we recognize the county positivity rates continue to climb.
